- Need consensus on post season eligibility requirements for 2021 only
 - Register and dues paid by 3/1/21
 - MC attendance yearly requirement?
 - Area Meeting attendance requirement?
 - 4 meetings?
 - Should meeting credit be given for umpiring a scrimmage/pre-season game?
 - Only one credit for a meeting (not multiple credits)
 - 3 person training requirement
 - How best to provide?
 - How to provide timely training before the postseason?
 - Varsity (max 18 game schedule)/Sub Varsity games requirement?
 - 7 Varsity and 2 Sub Varsity games?
 - Post season test minimum of 85%

- Post season eligibility, ranking and availability spreadsheet (draft enclosed) Greg
 - We agreed to use this last year
 - If anyone needs help with the spreadsheet use or filling out, contact Greg
 - o Final worksheet will be provided to include the eligibility decisions
 - o We may need to be flexible with how the post season assignments are done this year
 - The spreadsheet tracks:
 - All postseason eligibility requirements
 - ADs insert umpire ratings for classification, best position, last weekend to work, crew chief, last championship umpired
 - By mid-May, ADs collect availability for the 3 playoff weekends
 - Understand that there might be 5% who make changes
 - Identify any travel limits and/or blocked schools
 - Meeting with CHSAA in May (tbd) to identify championship umpires
 - There are 1A/2A districts games that need to be supported that coincide with the end of the regular season
 - We have to plan to provide umpires for these games
 - We should communicate with umpires as soon as possible for SF and Final's assignments
 - Need to make sure everyone is on the same page prior to communicating

- 2021 Rules Test Plan Greg/George
 - ~ 95% of the test questions are from past NFHS tests
 - Others from Referee guizzes or created to cover new rules
 - We had 10 umpires review the multiple-choice questions in the database
 - Each reviewed about 20 questions each
 - This corrected any typos
 - Reworded/eliminated any questions and answers that were not clear
 - Ross created the two person mechanics T/F questions
 - Using the same three person mechanics questions from last year's test
 - This plan requires umpires to take only one test
 - Umpires make their choice on which test to take
 - 3 chances to pass
 - Umpires only wanting to do <u>regular season games</u> including new umpires (unless an out of state transfer that wants to be postseason eligible) will have an 80 T/F rules questions AND 20 <u>two</u> person mechanics questions combined in one test. 100 questions total.
 - Required to pass test by May 2
 - This test would be available until June for any late joining umpires (i.e., after the season begins)
 - Note: post season interested umpire may take this test as preparation or for additional review
 - Umpires wanting to be <u>playoff eligible</u> including an out of state transfer will have a 60 multiple choice rules question test AND 20 <u>three</u> person mechanics questions combined in one test. 80 questions total.
 - Required to pass test by May 2
 - A decision is needed about the question pool size in order to submit for posting
- BOD members CHSBUA Registration, State Insurance and Arbiter Fees update
 - With the change in how fees are collected (1 for CHSBUA, 1 for insurance/arbiter):
 - BOD will still have the CHSBUA registration fee marked as paid by Monica
 - BOD will have to pay the \$17 insurance and arbiter fee due to how the site was created
 - BOD will receive a \$17 check for reimbursement
- 2021 Inactive umpire status
 - A question from an umpire about 2021 inactive status and fee prompted us to review and discuss:
 - Our Constitution/Bylaws under Art IV Membership, allows for inactive status for a medical issue, or a leave of absence and the cost of this is \$50.
 - With our veteran umpire dues only being \$10 for 2021, the following was approved by the Executive Committee:
 - CHSBUA "waives" the inactive status dollar amount and grants any
 umpire for the 2021 season, for whatever reason that wants to "optout", inactive status with no fee charge. This would allow them to
 return the following year with regular/normal registration fees.
 - "Opt-out" requests should be received by the Area Directors and forwarded to Terry for tracking

Rules Interpreter Report

- Open item from 3Q20
 - O How do we address umpires that need to replace rule books?
 - We do have 150 2020 rules books held by ADs and CHSAA
 - Should we charge them directly?
 - ADs to manage and will have to charge the official
- Large payments approval process Terry
 - o Revisited 2Q20 BOD item
 - We voted the following into the constitution
 - 1. If budget item, treasurer and president concurrence and would pay any below \$300
 - 2. If not a budget item and less than \$300 \$1000, executive committee will approve
 - 3. If not a budget item and more than \$1000, the BOD would approve
 - Reviewing this after our budget approval in 3Q20, believe that there is a need for a slight modification
 - Proposing the following modification to bullet number 1 (changing it to 2 bullets), a slight word change to bullet number 2 and no change to bullet number 3:
 - 1. If the invoice is part of the approved budget, Treasurer can pay
 - a. An approved budget example: \$2,300 payment to CHSAA
 - There shouldn't be any reason to revisit this between the Treasurer and President and should just be paid
 - 2. If not a budget item and less than \$300, Treasurer and President concurrence required
 - a. If flowers need to be sent or some incidentals purchased, the Treasurer and President would discuss about proceeding
 - 3. If not a budget item and between \$300 \$1000, executive committee will approve
 - 4. If not a budget item and more than \$1000, the BOD would approve
 - The final wording will read:
 - If the invoice is part of the approved budget, Treasurer can pay
 - If there are budget overages:
 - Less than \$300, Treasurer and President concurrence required
 - Between \$300 \$1000, executive committee will approve
 - More than \$1000, the BOD will approve

- If not a budget item and between \$300 \$1000, executive committee will approve
- If not a budget item and more than \$1000, the BOD will approve
